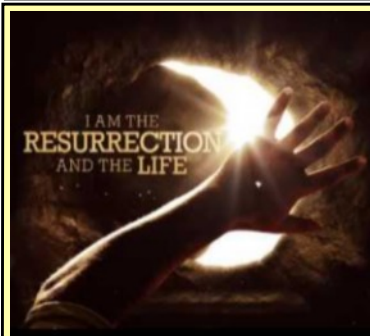
St Michael Archangel Prayer
