

Food for Thought

In today's Gospel Jesus speaks of the 'narrow door'. This presents both a challenge and an invitation for us. It's not about restriction but about direction. The narrow door isn't meant to frighten or discourage us but to awaken us to examine our lives. The narrow door means that we can't bring everything with us like, pride, selfishness, jealousy, unforgiveness etc. The image of the door is mentioned on various occasions in the Bible and makes us think of a door to a home – a place where we can find safety, love and warmth. This door is Jesus himself: He is the door. He leads us to the Father and that door is never closed. Our job as Christians is to try and tell those we meet about this. We may think there's lots we can't do - but we can focus on the things we can do; feeding the poor – showing kindness to those in need- a welcoming smile – a kind word etc. However we share our gifts, we will have opened the door to God's love, which is His gift to us. May He continue to pour His grace into our hearts giving us many opportunities for loving service!
