Priests in our Archdiocese: A recent statistic shows that we have 114 active diocesan priests in our parishes and pastoral work. 12 priests currently are over 75 and within the next couple of years will no longer be able to continue their ministry. In the next 5 years a further 22 priests will be in their late 70's, and should have already retired. So in the not too distant future we will only have 80 active diocesan priests. Our thanks go to those missionary priests from other parts of the world who are currently serving our parishes.

Appreciation: The parish has recently received a legacy gift from the estate of the Late Miss Kathleen Connelly to the tune of 10,000 pounds. This said fund has since been paid into the parish account. We use the avenue to appreciate the gift and to pray for the peaceful repose of Kathleen. Seven masses shall be offered by the parish for her peaceful repose. May God grant eternal rest to Kathleen and all the faithful departed. Amen.

Mission Appeal: In October, we shall have a visit from two different missionary orders to speak to us about their work and to solicit our continued spiritual and financial support.
