Holy Family Parish, Gaza: latest news from this parish which is one of the four in Israel and Palestine to which we have sent cards / supported since 2019. >> The Pope has attacked plans to evacuate Gaza City as priests and nuns caring for the sick refused to leave the war zone. A statement from the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem and his Greek Orthodox counterpart said that frail Palestinians would not survive such a move: fleeing to the south would be nothing less than a death sentence. Fr Gabriel Romanelli, parish priest of Holy Family Church, said they were caring for 450 people. "With great simplicity and humility we will continue," he told the Vatican's news service. "We are in the hands of God". About 1000 Christians are believed to be in Gaza.
